

Burnsville High School Expansion Public Improvements City Project 15-104

The City of Burnsville is currently planning for improvements to Portland Avenue and its intersection with Highway 13 during the summer of 2016. These improvements are necessary to accommodate the planned expansion of the Burnsville High School campus to allow for additional student capacity.

On the back of this notice is an exhibit illustrating the proposed upgrades along Highway 13 and Portland Avenue, which include the following improvements:

- Construction of an additional left turn lane on eastbound Highway 13 to northbound Portland Avenue
- Construction of a roundabout at the intersection of Portland Avenue and Burnsville High School entrance
- Additional turn lane and travel lane improvements along Portland Avenue
- Utility and storm sewer improvements
- Landscaping and street lighting improvements

The project is currently in the final design phase with the anticipation of construction being completed during the summer of 2016. Construction of the roundabout will require a closure of Portland Avenue from north of the TH 13 frontage road intersection to south of the southmost Bosch Industries driveway during school out time next year. Driveway access to all businesses will remain open, however access will only be available from either Cliff Road or from TH 13 during the project. The existing left turn lane from eastbound TH 13 to northbound Portland Ave will also likely be closed during the project for a long enough time to construct the additional turn lane.




