HEART RESTART TRAINING NOW OFFERED MONTHLY AT BURNSVILLE CITY HALL

Next Class is Wednesday, Feb. 17

Who will YOU save if you learn CPR?

That's the question being asked by the Burnsville Fire Department and the Burnsville Mobile Volunteer Network. The answer? Potentially anyone! Each year, sudden cardiac arrest kills approximately 325,000 Americans – more than car crashes; firearms; house fires; AIDS; and breast, prostate and colorectal cancer combined. What's more, this top killer can strike anyone, at any age, without warning.

In partnership with the Dakota County Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Council, Burnsville began the campaign "Heart Restart: Who Will YOU Save," in 2013 in an attempt to train 6,000 people in CPR.

To reach that goal, the **Burnsville Fire Department is offering free, one-hour CPR classes and materials to any individual, group or organization wishing to learn the lifesaving skill.** (The classes are in a new "Compression Only" format, and do not fulfill certification requirements.)

Classes are now being held the third Wednesday of every month. Residents, neighbors and anyone interested in learning this life-saving skill are invited to take part. RSVPs are encouraged to gauge the number of participants.
