Burnsville City Council Seeks Applicants for Advisory Commissions

Burnsville's City government can't work without people like you! The Burnsville City Council is once again looking for residents interested in serving on City advisory commissions. These positions are appointed by the City Council and are responsible for researching, reviewing and making recommendations on issues.

All terms begin on July 1, 2016, and are open to Burnsville residents ages 18 and older. Youth commission appointments are open to any Burnsville resident that will be a high school junior or senior in the fall of 2016. Membership on certain commissions is open to non-residents who own a business or property in Burnsville.

The application deadline is **Monday, May 2 at 4:30 p.m.** The City Council will conduct interviews for appointments in May. Opportunities for service are available on the following advisory commissions:

Economic Development Commission: Advisory body on economic development and business development.

Ames Center Advisory Commission: Advisory body that reviews, researches, and makes recommendations on issues related to the operation of the Ames Center.

Openings: **Two Regular Members – three-year term**
 One Alternate Member – three-year term

Planning Commission: Advisory body that reviews, researches and makes recommendations on issues related to land use and development.

Openings: **Two Regular Members – three-year term**
 One Regular Member – one-year term

Parks and Natural Resources Commission: Advisory body that reviews and makes recommendations on issues related to park, recreation and open space needs and protection of Burnsville's natural resources.

Openings: **Two Regular Members – three-year term**
 One Alternate Member – three-year term
 Two Youth Members – one-year term
