BURNSVILLE TO HOST OPEN HOUSE ON PROPOSED FACILITY RENOVATIONS AUG. 11

Burnsville City Hall and the adjoining Police Department (located at 100 Civic Center Parkway) were built in 1988. The multipurpose building has served the City for nearly 30 years without significant renovation. In 2014, the City contracted with *Wold Architects and Engineers* to conduct an independent “space needs” study for this and multiple other City facilities. The purpose of this study was to outline short- mid- and long-term plans that will help accommodate the City’s current and future space needs at multiple buildings.

What Renovations are Needed?

Based on the results of the study, the City is proposing a phased construction plan to deal with needed renovations. The first phase is meant to improve public safety, Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessibility, operational efficiencies and visitor convenience in City Hall and the Police Department. Key components currently identified in Phase 1 include:

- Redesign and Expansion of Police Department Property/Evidence Storage and Evidence Processing Space
- Redesign of Police Training, Conference and Office Space
- Redesign of Police Detention Area
- Redesign of City Hall Community and Meeting Room Space
- General Building, ADA Renovations

In addition, Phase 1 also includes developing a long-term master plan for Burnsville Fire Station No. 1 (911 140th St. W.), conceptual design plans for the City’s former maintenance facility, and the study of a potential covered storage garage for police vehicles.

Open House

Members of the public are invited to meet with the architects/design team involved in the City’s renovation project. There, they will learn more about the project and have an opportunity to provide feedback on the schematic design for the City Hall and Police Department buildings.

The Burnsville City Council will be reviewing the Schematic Design for Phase 1 at their Monday, Aug. 8 City Council Meeting (Burnsville City Hall, 100 Civic Center Parkway). The Council will be considering final design later this fall.
