### **RECYCLE SHOES IN BURNSVILLE, APPLE VALLEY AND EAGAN NOV. 14-20**

Instead of throwing away old or unwanted shoes, residents in Burnsville, Apple Valley and Eagan can once again recycle them during a free one-week collection.

In honor of America Recycles Day Nov. 15, **residents will be able to drop off shoes from Monday, Nov. 14 to Sunday, Nov. 20** at locations in each community.

Shoes of all types, sizes and styles, in any condition, will be accepted. The effort is coordinated by Dakota Valley Recycling, the shared municipal recycling department for the Cities of Apple Valley, Burnsville and Eagan.

In 2015, the one-week collection event prevented nearly six tons of shoes from going to the landfill.
