When: Saturday, April 29 | 7-10 a.m.

(or until all trees are sold)

Where: 75 Civic Center Parkway (Across from Burnsville City Hall)

Bare root tree prices range from \$20-\$55. Quantities are limited to two trees per household. Trees are locally grown and vary in size from 5 to 12 feet. Only cash or checks will be accepted.

**Please note that Native Plants and Shrubs will NOT be sold at the Tree Sale. They will be available at the Native Plant Market to be held on May 20.

Tree Sale Tips:

- Prepare planting sites before attending the sale
- Call Gopher State One-Call (651-454-0002) to have utilities marked before digging
- Arrive early for the best selection
- Try to determine what trees you want before the sale
- Plan to plant bare root trees immediately
- Protect trees against damage from deer and rodents until they are well established; consider placing protection around them for the first few years
- Get a permit from the City if you plan to plant a tree within the boulevard/right-of-way on your property (15 feet in from the curb)
