Paperwork with confidential information should be shredded to prevent the possibility of identity theft but not all documents need to be shredded. In fact, shredded paper wears down the fibers making it more difficult to recycle. Please shred only what you need to and recycle the rest.

Shredding will occur onsite, meaning all documents will be shredded immediately. No need to remove staples or paper clips. Please remove larger binder clips and rubber bands in advance.
