## **BURNSVILLE CITY COUNCIL MEETING START TIMES CHANGE TO 5:30 P.M. BEGINNING TUESDAY, OCT. 24**

On Oct. 3, the Burnsville City Council voted unanimously to start its meetings at 5:30 p.m.

Beginning with their Oct. 24 budget work session, all City Council regular meetings and work sessions will start one hour earlier – at 5:30 p.m. instead of 6:30 p.m. This change does not affect Burnsville’s advisory commissions (Planning, Parks & Natural Resources, Economic Development and Ames Center) – all of which will continue to start at 6:30 p.m.

The Council chose to change their meeting start times, stating that the earlier time is more convenient for most residents, business owners, developers and consultants who attend Council meetings.

### **Meeting Dates**

Regular City Council Meetings are typically held on the first and third Tuesday (after the first Monday) of every month. Work Sessions are typically held the second Tuesday (after the first Monday) of every month. Meetings are held at Burnsville City Hall, 100 Civic Center Parkway.
