The City of Burnsville, in partnership with the City of Eagan, offers men's and mixed/co-rec broomball for players age 18 and older. Opportunities to play are available to teams/players from outside of Burnsville.

Men's League (Jan 1 – Feb. 5)

This double-header league takes place Monday nights over six weeks from early January to early February. Registration will remain open until spots are filled or Friday, Dec. 8.

This league is played outdoors on Friday nights from early January to mid-February.
