City offices will also be open for absentee voting on:

- Saturday, Aug. 11 from 10 a.m. – 3 p.m.
- Monday, Aug. 13 until 5 p.m.

Requesting an Absentee Ballot

Absentee voting applications may also be completed online, or to residents electronically. Voters should note that this refers to the APPLICATION ONLY. They will still need to submit their ballot by mail or drop off at City Hall.

All absentee ballots must be submitted by 3 p.m. on Election Day (Aug. 14). Any eligible voter may vote absentee; absence from the precinct on Election Day is no longer required.
