**CONSTRUCTION TO BEGIN ON NORTH SEGMENT (ROSE BLUFF)
OF LAKE MARION GREENWAY IN BURNSVILLE AUG. 20**

The Lake Marion Greenway is a 20-mile planned trail through Burnsville, Savage, Credit River Township, Lakeville and Farmington, with the intention of linking the Minnesota River to the Murphy Hanrehan Park Reserve.

The City of Burnsville and local area partners are currently working on both a north and south segment of the trail.

North Segment Construction Begins Aug. 20

Construction on the **North Segment (Rose Bluff)** will begin the week of Aug. 20, primarily with tree clearing and preparatory work to start, and then moving into full construction.

The North Segment will be approximately a half-mile of trail, and will run north and south between Kraemer Nature Preserve and Williams Drive. Construction is anticipated to be complete by Oct. 31.
