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CONSTRUCTION BEGINS ON OLD ARCHERY RANGE SITE, NEW SITE ON ZENITH AVENUE EXPECTED TO OPEN LATE SEPTEMBER

In 2016, the City of Burnsville was approached by representatives from Dodge of Burnsville requesting to purchase City-owned land at 12151 Pleasant Ave. The land, which abuts the Dodge dealership, was formerly to the City's public archery range.

The Burnsville City Council approved the land sale to Dodge of Burnsville in November 2017. The agreement included a contribution of \$14,000 by Dodge of Burnsville (in addition to the land purchase price) toward the construction of a new archery range.

Construction Begins on Old Range Site

Dodge of Burnsville began construction on the old archery range site earlier this week. Residents are reminded that the site is no longer City property, and is closed to the public.

Archer Park to Open Late September

Construction on the new range, which will be known as Archer Park (12701 Zenith Ave. S.) has begun. The new site is expected to open in Late September.

Archer Park will include:

- approximately two acres of land dedicated to the range
- a berm/safety fence
- target distance ranging from 10 to 80 yards
- parking for 10 to 12 vehicles
