ABSENTEE VOTING FOR NOVEMBER GENERAL ELECTION BEGINS SEPT. 21

Absentee voting for the Nov. 6 General election will open in Burnsville on Friday, Sept. 21. Those wishing to vote absentee may do so through Monday, Nov. 5

Beginning Sept. 21, absentee voting will be available in person at:

Burnsville City Hall
100 Civic Center Parkway
Monday through Friday
8 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.

City offices will also be open for absentee voting on:

- Saturday, Nov. 3 from 10 a.m. – 3 p.m.
- Monday, Nov. 5 until 5 p.m.

Requesting an Absentee Ballot

Absentee ballots can also be mailed to voters. Voters must first complete an “absentee ballot application.” This can be done online, or an application can be sent by mail.

Voters should note that this refers to the APPLICATION ONLY. Once the application is processed, voters will receive their absentee ballot by mail. Voters must still submit their ballot by mail or drop off at City Hall.

All absentee ballots must be submitted by 3 p.m. on Election Day (Nov. 6). Any eligible voter may vote absentee; absence from the precinct on Election Day is no longer required.
