NEW PICKLEBALL COURT AT RED OAK PARK IN BURNSVILLE

This fall, Burnsville opened a new pickleball court complex at Red Oak Park, 12100 River Hills Drive. The newly constructed complex has six pickleball courts, one combination court and one tennis court – and will be lit to provide the ability to play at night.

About Pickleball

Pickleball is a racquet sport that is great for all ages, including seniors and children. It combines elements of badminton, tennis and table tennis. The sport is played on a court with the same dimensions as a doubles badminton court. The net is similar to a tennis net, but is mounted two inches lower. The game is played with a hard paddle and a polymer wiffle ball.

Pickleball Courts

Burnsville now has five parks striped with pickleball courts. They are:

- North River Hills Park, 11501 19th Ave.
- Neill Park, 13501 Upton Ave. (*lighted court*)
- Wood Park, 701 E. 143rd St.
- Colonial Park, 1300 W. 139th St.
