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DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT WORKSHEET FOR PROPOSED HEALEY-RAMME PROJECT AVAILABLE

Public Comment Opportunity Through Nov. 21

As part of the proposed Healey-Ramme development in Burnsville, the City has commissioned an environmental assessment of the area where construction is being considered. An Environmental Assessment Worksheet (EAW) is now available for review and comment.

Results of the study and instructions to provide feedback are available online at www.burnsville.org/planning, under the “Projects” tab. Public comment is due by Wednesday, Nov. 21.

About the Proposed Development

The study is of an approximately 31-acre area located in the northeast portion of Southcross Drive West and Grand Avenue, generally located at the southeast corner of I-35E/I-35W and County Road 42. The Healey-Ramme project proposes the development of 459 multifamily residential units, consisting of two apartment sites and a townhome project. Twin Lake is partially located within the project boundary on the southeast corner of the site.

About the Environmental Assessment Worksheet

By State statute, this level of development requires a mandatory EAW. Copies have been distributed to agencies listed on the most current Minnesota Environmental Quality Board (EQB) distribution list. Published notice of this EAW will occur in the EQB Monitor on Monday, Oct. 22. Paper copies are also available for review at Burnsville City Hall (100 Civic Center Parkway) and the Minneapolis Central Branch of the Hennepin County Public Library (300 Nicollet Mall, Minneapolis).
