REGISTRATION FOR MEN'S, CO-REC BROOMBALL LEAGUES OPENS NOV. 5-6

Let's play this winter, Burnsville! The fun doesn't stop just because the weather turns cold. Friends and neighbors are invited to join a league in one of Minnesota's favorite sports -- broomball.

The City of Burnsville offers men's leagues on Monday nights, and mixed/co-rec broomball (in partnership with the City of Eagan) on Friday nights for players age 18 and older. Opportunities to play are available for teams/players from outside of Burnsville.

Men's League (Jan 7 – Feb. 11)

This double-header league takes place Monday nights over six weeks from early January to mid-February. Registration will open Tuesday, Nov. 6 and remain open until spots are filled or Friday, Dec. 14.

How to Register:

- Register online or download the "2019 Men's Broomball Registration Form" from www.burnsville.org/broomball. (Return form and payment to Burnsville City Hall, 100 Civic Center Parkway, Burnsville, MN 55337)

Men's teams are \$355 per team.

Mixed/Co-Rec League (Jan. 4 – Feb. 8)

The South of the River Recreators (S.O.R.R.), which consists of the cities of Apple Valley, Burnsville, Eagan, Farmington, Lakeville, Rosemount and Savage sponsor this league.

This league is played outdoors on Friday nights from early January to mid-February. Registration for returning teams opens Monday, Nov. 5. New teams can begin registering Monday, Nov. 12.

- To register a team, complete a registration/roster form and submit full payment to Eagan Parks & Recreation during the appropriate registration dates.

Mixed/Co-Rec Teams are \$240 per team.
