Kick and pass! Preschool soccer helps youngsters ages 4–6 develop a lifelong love of the game while learning to play on a team. Curriculum includes energetic, all-inclusive games that teach young kids the basics.

Rookie T-ball Camp is a pre-kindergarten t-ball program that allows children the chance to learn the basic fundamentals of baseball in a summer camp-like approach. Each session starts with warm-ups and exercises followed by a general skill session. Parents and players then work together on specific skill areas.
